WARM UP STAKES

JUDGE – MRS L DUN

- Class 1 RUSTIC FENCES jumps not exceeding 60 cms Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old an over, any height, plaited, unplaited or M&M. Rider any age.
- Class 2 RUSTIC FENCES jumps not exceeding 70 cms Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old an over, any height, plaited, unplaited or M&M. Rider any age.
- Class 3 RUSTIC FENCES jumps not exceeding 80 cms Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old an over, any height, plaited, unplaited or M&M. Rider any age.

METHOD OF JUDGING: Animals will be required to jump a course of fences and will immediately be asked to give a short show, including a change of rein, in the same ring.

WARM UP STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 to 3

RING 1 – to follow WARM UP STAKES MRS J HUNTER

Class 4 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER – jumps not exceeding 85 cms Open to horses 4 years old and over, 15 hh (153 cm) and over. Not to have won a novice class prior to 1st January 2021.

Class 5 PERTH EQUINE VETS/BHS SCOTLAND WORKING HUNTER Horses must be 15hh or over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years old or over. To compete at the final, either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS. Course: 8-12 fences approx 3'6", judged in line with Sports Horse GB rules.

> The first three partnerships will qualify even if they have not jumped clear. If one of these has already qualified, their qualification may be handed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they had a clear round in the jumping. If a class has less than 4 entries only the winner will qualify for the Championships.

To compete at the FINAL riders must be a BHS Member and this must be registered prior to the date of the final.

- Class 6 NOVICE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY jumps not exceeding 60 cms Open to stallions, mares and geldings 5 years old & over. Not to have won a novice class prior to 1st January 2022.
- Class 7 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY jumps not exceeding 60 cms Open to mares and geldings 5 years old & over not exceeding 15hh. Riders 18 years old and under. Not to have won a novice class prior to 1st January 2022.
- Class 8 OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY jumps not exceeding 85 cms Open to stallions, mares and geldings 5 years old & over.
- Class 9 OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY jumps not exceeding 85 cms Open to mares and geldings 5 years old & over not exceeding 15hh. Riders 18 years old and under.

- Class 22 PONY CLUB PONY ponies not exceeding 148 cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *Competitors will be asked to walk, trot and canter and to jump 2 small fences*
- Class 23 PONIES not exceeding 128 cms. On leading rein riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

JUDGE – MISS K REDFEARN


- Class 27 EX RACEHORSE IN HAND open to any ex racehorse 3 years and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.
- Class 28 EX RACEHORSE RIDDEN open to any ex racehorse 4 years and over. Horse should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. The judge will not ride.

EX RACEHORSE CHAMPIONSHIP Open to the 1^{st} & 2^{nd} prize winners from classes 27 & 28

SHOW JUMPING

- Class 29 BEGINNERS Maximum height of jumps 60 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
 Class 30 NURSERY Maximum height of jumps 70 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
 Class 31 NOVICE Maximum height of jumps 80 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
- Class 32 INTERMEDIATE Maximum height of jumps 90 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider
